



## Lycopene 10 mg Capsules

Nutritional supplement

**Valuable information:** Lycopene, also called leucopin, belongs to the class of carotenoids. In high concentrations, lycopene is found in tomatoes, which give it its characteristic red colour. In the field of nutrition, lycopene is increasingly attracting attention due to various trials over the past few years. The added vitamin E also plays a role in protecting cells against oxidative stress.

**Ingredients:** bulking agents Linseed Oil, Sunflower Oil; Gelatine, humectant Glycerine, Vitamin E, Lycopene (1.5%), colouring agent Iron Oxide.
